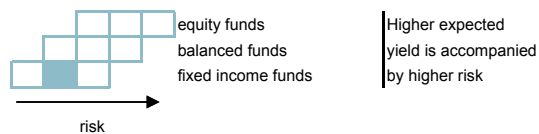

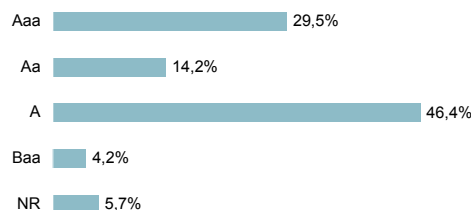

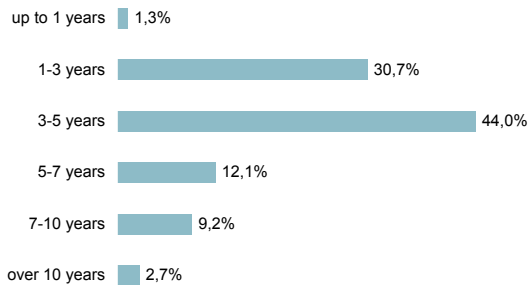
Portfolio by instruments
