






Portfolio by instruments



Portfolio by modified duration



The following payment which conditionally consists of two parts - tax (4% portion of the social tax) and contribution (2% contribution of the state funded pension, withheld by the employer on the employee's gross wages) - shall be transferred to the mandatory funded pension account for a person who has joined the funded pension system.
