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

The Fund's assets may be invested in shares or in the investment funds dealing with investments in shares to the extent of 25% of the market value of the Fund's assets.




Higher expected yield is accompanied by higher risk

Proportion

The value of the Fund's unit can either grow or decrease in time. The current return of the Fund shall not guarantee the same return in the future. Funds investing in foreign markets are vulnerable to monetary movements, which may lead to a growth or decrease of the net asset value of the Fund's unit. Pension Funds are founded on the basis of Funded Pensions Act.The following payment which conditionally consists of two parts - tax (4% portion of the social tax) and contribution (2% contribution of the state funded pension, withheld by the employer on the employee's gross wages) - shall be transferred to the mandatory funded pension account for a person who has joined the funded pension system.
