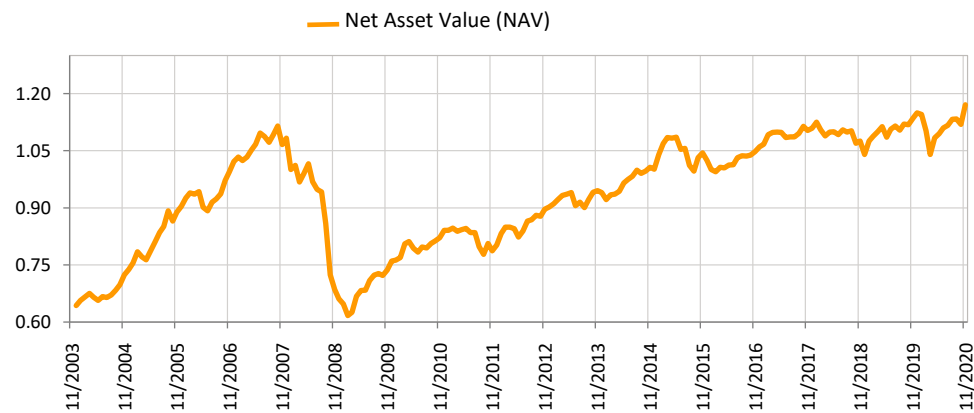
## Investment principles

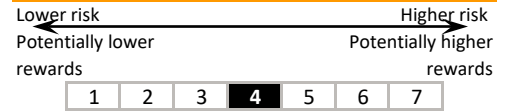

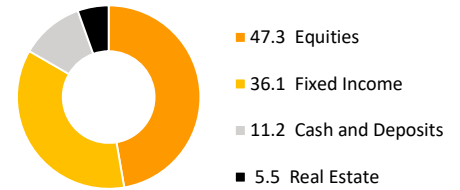

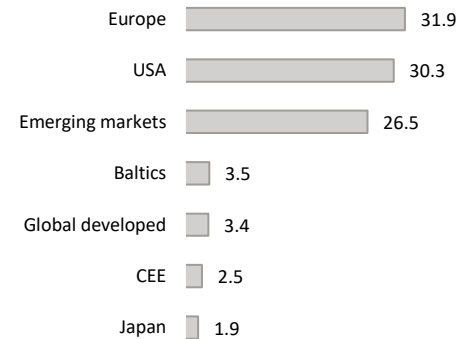


The categories specified in the risk scale are based on the fluctuation of the value of the Fund's assets during the last five years.

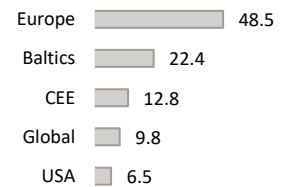
## Asset allocation (%)
